1978 Chevrolet Corvette Limited Edition Pace Car

The 1978 Corvette was the first ever Corvette to pace the most famous of races; the Indianapolis 500. In celebration of this occasion, Chevrolet took it's 1978 Silver Anniversary Commemorative Edition and produced 6,502 Limited Edition Pace Car replicas for sale to the public, one for each dealer. This particular car is number 5,428 of the 6,502 produced.

Each dealer was assigned a single Pace Car and they were besieged with orders. Enthusiasts who heard early about the Replicas ordered them with their local dealers at list price or a discount. But when some dealers realized what was happening they returned early deposits, while others hiked up the price by thousands. Even options on ordered cars were traded for thousands. Attorneys litigated, grown men wept, and such was the speculative hype that the story made the front page of the Wall Street Journal on March 27, 1978. Some cars really did change hands for as much as \$50,000. – Total miles in 2010 is 8,500 miles
